INVESTMENT BY LAUNCH NY SEED FUND BUILDS ON TEAM EFFORT BY ECOSYSTEM PARTNERS COMMITTED TO ENTREPRENEURSHIP

Most Active Seed Fund in Region Announces \$50,000 Investment in Digital Job Training
Tools Company

Upstate New York, March 13, 2018 – Launch New York (Launch NY), Upstate New York's first and only venture development organization (VDO) to provide pro bono mentoring and capital access to high-growth potential startup businesses across the 27 westernmost counties of New York State, today announced it will invest \$50,000 in Buffalo based, GRASPIE™, in part supported by a recent 3-year funding commitment by Viaduct, a startup business focused subsidiary of Williamsville-based Aleron, (formerly Superior Group), a premier provider of workforce and outsourcing solutions around the globe. Launch NY's funding and mentorship augments the team effort to assist GRASPIE that has included business support resources from the Buffalo Urban League and Buffalo Niagara Medical Campus' Design Innovation Garage.

With more than 80 applications from client companies, Launch NY is the most active seed fund in Upstate NY with investments in 24 portfolio companies in less than two years. Launch NY is continuing its raise to fully capitalize the Launch NY Seed fund at \$5MM from investors and funders, such as Viaduct, who want to support innovation and economic transformation through startups. In order to grow the regional ecosystem's capabilities, Launch NY is also leveraging its status as the only US Treasury designated Community Development Financial Institution (CDFI) committed to providing investment capital and technical assistance to entrepreneurs in low to moderate income communities in New York.

"Individual entrepreneurs and the whole community win when we can work in partnership across diverse organizations to support our startup businesses," said Marnie LaVigne, PhD, President and CEO of Launch NY. "We will continue to coordinate with ecosystem leaders, like Viaduct and so many others, to provide GRASPIETM with pro bono mentoring alongside our investment dollars. By helping GRASPIETM achieve key milestones, one of our most dynamic entrepreneurs will be able to get his product in the market and in turn attract additional investment capital for the next stage of growth."
